

## **Camping Bakkum House Rules**

Welcome to Camping Bakkum. We love having you here! To ensure that everyone has a great holiday, we need to agree on a few rules so that we can all enjoy everything Camping Bakkum has to offer.

If you'd like to read through all our house rules, then please do. You'll find them below.

### **Camping pitch and Camping Vehicle**

- Pets are not allowed, except clearly recognizable assistance dogs.
- A maximum of 6 people can stay on the camping pitch.
- One main camping vehicle may be placed on the camping pitch.
- The Tourist camping pitches allow a vehicle with a maximum length of 8.50 metres, as long as it fits.
- It is prohibited to place objects outside the boundary of the hired camping pitch.
- If you receive people who stay overnight then these must be registered, and the appropriate fees must be paid.
- If you get a visitor, they must be registered.
- Young people under the age of 21 are not allowed to camp unaccompanied by an adult.
- Groups of young people, irrespective of age, are not allowed to camp at family Camping Bakkum.
- Camping in groups is not permitted.
- It is not allowed to use a saw, secateurs or clip the vegetation on the site in any other way.
- The camping pitch must be left clean before departure.

### **Cars and other vehicles**

- Only one car can go through the barrier onto the campsite, per pitch/rental accommodation. The barrier will open on the license plate number, if it is registered in the reservation.
- When you booked a pitch/rental accommodation with car parking, then you can of course park there. The area can be accessed from 07.00 to 22.00.
- When you booked a pitch/rental accommodation without car parking, you must park your car in the central car park P2 or P3. This car park is accessible 24/7.
- We request that you drive at walking pace for the safety of playing children.
- Electrical means of transport, such as a scooter, (cargo)bike or fatbike are

only permitted if they comply with the Road Traffic Act.

- The use of quad bikes, mopeds, scooters or mini bikes on the campsite is prohibited.
- Vehicles are not to cause any nuisance on the site.
- Parking trailers or campers is not permitted.
- Charging an electric car is only permitted at the designated charging points in the car park. When your car is charged we request you to remove it and park it in a normal parking space.
- Should you receive visitors then they can make use of the paid car park P2 or P3.
- Normal road traffic rules are in force on the campsite.

### **Hygiene and washrooms**

- There are underground waste containers on the site. You must dispose of your general waste, tied up in bags, here. There are additional containers for paper, glass, plastic, metal, drinks containers and large waste.
- It is not permitted to be in the washroom without reasonable purpose and/or cause a nuisance.
- We would appreciate it when children up to 7 years old are accompanied when visiting the washrooms.
- Toilet buckets and used wash water may only be emptied or disposed of in the designated space at the washrooms.
- Be judicious in your water use. It is not allowed to attach a hose to any water taps.

### **Access to the surrounding natural areas**

- You have received Dune Passes per email. Please take your dune pass with you every time you visit the dune area. It will give you free access to the Kennemerduinen from sunrise to sunset. Please take note of the conditions displayed near the entrances.

### **Additional camping rules**

- Open fires are strictly prohibited with a view to wildfires. Barbecuing is only allowed on gas or electricity.
- We request that everyone respects the peace and quiet at the campsite. A noise curfew is in place after 22:00.
- Mobile sound media causing a nuisance are prohibited.
- Swimming pools are not permitted on a Season Pitch, except for paddling pools with a diameter of maximally 1.20 metres and a depth of maximally 30

cm.

- It is prohibited to possess, use or trade drugs.
- Drinking alcohol or be in possession of opened bottles, cans or such containing alcoholic beverages is not permitted other than on the camping pitch and cafe or restaurants.
- The use of generators to generate electricity is not allowed.
- It is not allowed to offer any merchandise on the campsite.
- The use of a drone is prohibited at Camping Bakkum.

Whenever a member of staff speaks to you in relation to your behaviour, you must act on their directions immediately. This also applies to following instructions by First Aiders (evacuation), other aid workers or any Camping Bakkum staff.

All agreements with Kennemer Duincampings are subject to RECRON-conditions. In addition, all local rules by Castricum Council apply on the campsite. In cases where the rules do not provide, the Manager will decide.
