

Camping Bakkum House Rules

Welcome to our campsite! We are delighted that you are staying with us! With so many different people together, it is important that we have some rules. This will help us to make everyone's stay as pleasant as possible. Let's enjoy everything Camping Bakkum has to offer together.

Camping pitch and camping equipment

- Pets are not allowed, except for assistance dogs that are recognizable as such.
- A maximum of 6 people may stay overnight on the camping pitch.
- One main camping equipment may be placed on the camping pitch.
- On the tourist pitches, the maximum permitted total length of the camping equipment is 8.50 m, if it fits on the pitch.
- It is not permitted to place objects outside the rented pitch.
- If you have guests staying overnight, they must be registered and pay the corresponding accommodation costs.
- If you have visitors, they must be registered.
- Young people under the age of 21 are not allowed to camp independently.
- Young people in groups, regardless of age, are not allowed to camp independently at Camping Bakkum.
- Camping in groups is not permitted.
- Sawing and/or pruning on the grounds is not permitted.
- Upon departure, the camping spot must be left clean.

Cars and other vehicles

- One car per rented pitch/accommodation may access the campsite. The barrier will open for the license plate number listed in the reservation.
- If you have reserved a pitch/accommodation where cars are allowed to park, you may of course park your car there. The campsite is accessible from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- If you have reserved a pitch/accommodation where cars are not allowed to be parked, you may park your car in the central parking lot P2 or P3, which is accessible 24 hours a day.
- For safety reasons and because there are many children playing, the maximum speed on the campsite is walking pace.
- Electric vehicles such as scooters, cargo bikes, or fat bikes are only permitted if they comply with traffic regulations.
- Quads, mopeds, scooters, and minibikes are not permitted on the campsite.
- Vehicles must not cause any nuisance on the campsite.
- Trailers and campers are not permitted.
- Electric cars may only be charged at the designated charging points in the parking lot. Once your car is charged, we ask that you park it in a regular parking space.
- If you have visitors, they can use the paid parking spaces P2 or P3.
- The Road Traffic Act applies on the campsite.

Hygiene and sanitary facilities

- There are underground waste containers on the grounds. You can deposit your household waste here in tightly tied bags. There are also waste bins for paper, glass, and household waste.
- It is not permitted to stay in the sanitary buildings without a reasonable purpose or in a disruptive manner.
- We greatly appreciate it if children under the age of 7 are accompanied to the sanitary buildings.
- Toilet buckets and wastewater may only be emptied in the designated chemical toilet area of the sanitary buildings.
- Use water wisely. Connecting garden hoses to the water taps is not permitted.

Access to the surrounding nature reserves

You have received dune maps from us by email. Please always take these with you when visiting the dune area. This gives you free access to the North Holland Dune Reserve from sunrise to sunset. You can read all the conditions of access at the entrances to the dune reserve.

Other camping rules

- Barbecuing is only permitted using gas or electricity. Open fires are prohibited for fire prevention reasons.
- We ask everyone to respect the peace and quiet on the campsite. After 10 p.m., quiet hours apply on the grounds.
- Mobile sound devices that cause nuisance are not permitted.
- Playground equipment such as slides, swings, trampolines, and paddling pools (max. 1.20 meters wide and max. 30 cm deep) are permitted.
- Play equipment such as slides, swings, trampolines, and children's pools (max. 1.20 meters wide and max. 30 cm deep) are permitted within the boundaries of the camping pitch. These must be removed or rendered unusable when not in use. This is to prevent accidents.
- The possession, use, or sale of drugs is not permitted. -
It is not permitted to consume alcoholic beverages or to have opened bottles, cans, and the like containing alcoholic beverages with you, except on the camping pitch and in the catering establishments.
- The use of generators to produce electricity is not permitted.
- Offering goods for sale is not permitted on the campsite.
- The use of drones is not permitted at Camping Bakkum.
- Our campsite is equipped with camera surveillance. For your safety and theirs, our security guards are equipped with body cameras.

If an employee addresses you about your behaviour, you must follow their instructions immediately. This also applies to following instructions (evacuation) from emergency response team members, emergency responders, or employees of Camping Bakkum.

All agreements of Kennemer Duincampings are subject to the RECRON terms and conditions. All rules of the General Local Regulation of the municipality of Castricum also apply here. In cases not covered by the regulations, the manager will decide.
